

Okanagan Lake Access Study

Overview of Individual Rights of Way

Site 3 – Intersection of Tronson Road and Foster Road

A good quality site to be developed for community access

Priority: 11

Overview of Site:

- This right of way provides for good access to the Lake and has an attractive beach.
- There is room to construct six parking spaces along Foster Road as part of the reconstruction of Tronson.
- The site may play an important role in giving upland residents in the future development at Tavistock access to the Lake.
- Ideally, this access could be linked along the shoreline to the Foster Road boat launch (Site 2), but it is interrupted by docks

Recommended Actions:

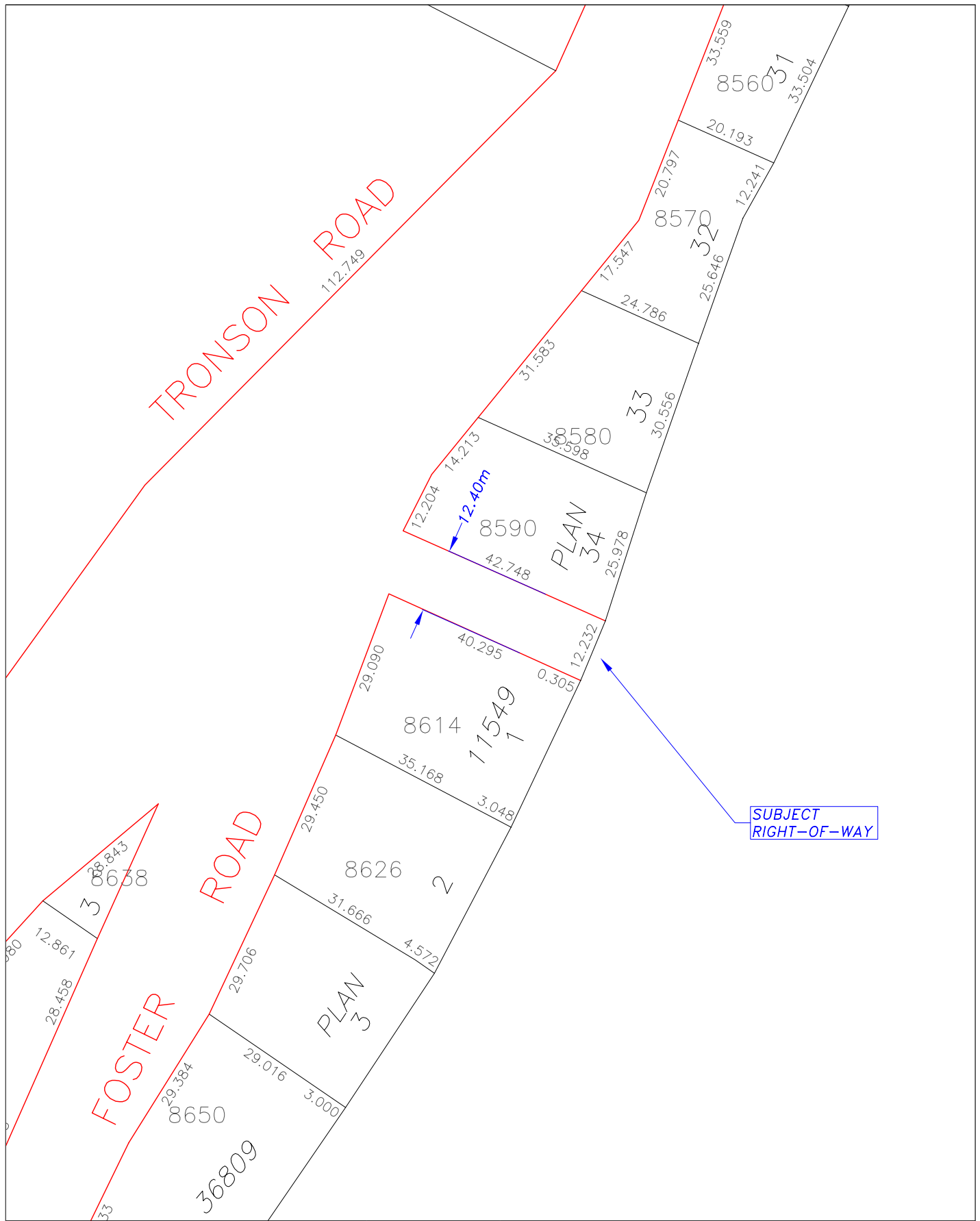
- clean up, landscape, and screen the right of way.
- install two picnic tables
- construct parking along Foster Road.
- construct a trail from the road to the Lake.
- explore possibility of connecting this Site and Site 2.

Estimated Budget:

The estimated cost of the works identified is \$ 40,110.

Specific Considerations:

- The impact of developing this site on the adjacent properties will need to be dealt with through the design process.
