### **Invitation to Proponents**

This Invitation to Tender (the "ITT") is an invitation by The Corporation of the City of Vernon (the "City") to prospective bidders to submit bids for the construction of the **Construction Services**, as further described in the ITT Particulars (the "Deliverables").

The **Construction of Lake Access Sites 22 & 25** project generally consists of the construction of active transportation, drainage, and site feature improvements at two sites:

#### Site 22 - 3000 Lakeshore Road:

- Concrete plaza and bus stop pad
- Intersection Improvements
- Approximately 80m of asphalt pathway
- Approximately 100m of road widening
- o 6m x 3m pedestrian bridge installation
- Drainage improvements including a 900mm culvert

#### Site 25 – 8797 Okanagan Landing Road:

- Lake access site improvements
- Parking, walkway and crosswalk
- Drainage improvements
- Traffic calming signage and road markings
- Landscape improvements
