This notice of Request for Quotations (the “RFQ”) is issued by The Corporation of the City of Vernon in British Columbia, Canada (the “City”) to prospective Bidders to submit non-binding quotations for the **Kal Tire Place Condenser Replacement**.

Work includes the supply, delivery, and installation of a new fluid cooling unit that will add significant enhancements to safety with all ammonia coolant contained within the mechanical room utilizing 45% less coolant and operating without for 90% of the year.
