Invitation:

This Request for Quotations (the “RFQ”) is an invitation by The Corporation of the City of Vernon (the “City”) to prospective respondents to submit non-binding quotations for the provision of **Sodium Hypochlorite** as further described in the RFQ Particulars (**Appendix D**) (the deliverables”).

The Corporation of the City of Vernon is requesting quotations for the supply and delivery of liquid Sodium Hypochlorite.

The product is the most widely used chlorine disinfectant for the inactivation of waterborne pathogens in drinking water supplies and historically has arguably made the greatest contribution to the public health protection of consumers. In addition to its use as a primary disinfectant post treatment, the residual level which remains in the distribution systems ensures that the microbiological compliance can be quality assured to the consumer tap as well as safeguarding against recontamination in the distribution system.
