# REQUEST FOR PRE-QUALIFICATIONS

### Invitation to Proponents:

Through this Request for Pre-Qualifications, the City of Vernon invites submissions from companies that are interested in the construction / installation of Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP).

The CIPP relining includes approximately 1312 lineal meters of sanitary pipe of various sizes and 878 lineal meters of Storm pipe of various sizes including service laterals where applicable, throughout the City of Vernon. The Contractor will be responsible for traffic control however this pre-qualification does not require traffic control companies to submit.

The scope of services will also include close coordination with the City's Technical Consultants Stantec , Ministry of Transportation and other appropriate outside agencies and City staff.

The successful Contractor will provide all labour, equipment, supplies, and services required to fulfill the scope of work as outlined in **Part B – Scope of Work** and the accompanying **Appendix A – 50 % Design Drawings**.
