Submission Requirements

Application submission shall contain (but not limited to Soil Removal and Deposition Bylaw #5259) the following:

Type 'A' Permit

- ÿ A letter outlining why and where the soil is to be removed and deposited.
- ÿ A site plan clearly identifying the area of land from which the soil is sought to be removed and deposited including all pertinent topographic features (structures, watercourses, roads, trees, etc.).
- ÿ A plan showing location of source material, proposed stockpiles or material placement sites (onsite or offsite). Where soils are being removed from a site, the haul route must be defined and if outside of City limits, confirmation of notification to the Regional District of North Okanagan or the appropriate governing body provided.
- ÿ Detailed plans providing Erosion and Sediment Control (ESC) measures (temporary and permanent), including a description of the type of soil(s) or other material being moved.
- ÿ A plan providing the methods of drainage, overland flow route, erosion and sediment controls for the site during and after the **removal** or **deposit** operation.

Type 'B' Permit

In addition to the requirements set out in 'Type A' Permit, the items listed below are required. Every application for Type "B" permit shall include all detailed plans, data and specifications prepared by a registered Professional Engineer or Geoscientist of the Province of British Columbia, or any other qualified professional.

- ÿ Detailed plans of the proposed grading of the site in its final state upon completion of the removal or deposition, showing areas and depth of fill and the correlation to all adjacent lands; with contours at no greater than 1-meter intervals, showing the methods of access and positive methods of permanent drainage on a separate plan.
- ÿ Detailed calculations, cross-sections and other engineering data used in calculating the estimated volume of soil (cubic meters) to be removed, relocated or deposited.

Additional Requirements for Blasting - Soil Removal and Deposition Bylaw #5259, Section 6.3 F

- ÿ A plan of the area to be blasted (including separation distances from any adjacent developed lands and buildings).
- ÿ Provision of the blaster's contact information and proof of certification.
- ÿ Detailed plans covering the proposed site and all adjacent lands, showing all pertinent topographic features, including existing buildings, structures, wells, drainage paths, environmentally sensitive areas and significant trees as defined in the Tree Protection Bylaw #4152 prior to the start of work.

Type 'A': Soil quantity between 50-99 cubic meters
Type 'B': Soil quantity > 99 cubic meters and/or;
Within an Environmentally Sensitive Area and/or;
Requires Blasting and/or;
Alters or affects overland drainage routes or a watercourse
Refer to CoV Soil Removal and Deposition Bylaw #5259
