

# 13.3 CD3: Comprehensive Development Area 3

# 13.3.1 **Purpose**

The purpose is to provide a **zone** for the **development** of a multi-family residential project under a housing agreement pursuant to Section 4.9, with a provision for a care centre in the project.

# 13.3.2 Primary Uses

- \* apartment housing
- \* row housing

(\* the above noted uses are subject to a housing agreement pursuant to Section 4.9)

## 13.3.3 Secondary Uses

- Care centre, minor
- Care centre, major
- Home Based Businesses, minor

## 13.3.4 Subdivision Regulations

- Minimum lot area is 8,000 sq.m.
- Minimum lot width is 35.0 m.

#### 13.3.5 Development Regulations

- Maximum site coverage is 40%
- Maximum density is 49.5 units/hectare (20 units/acre)
- Maximum height for:
  - > Apartment housing is 13.0m
  - > Row housing is 11.0m
- Minimum side yard is 3.0m
- Minimum side yard is 3.0m
- Minimum rear yard is 6.0m

#### 13.3.6 Other Regulations

- Secure and functional bicycle parking and storage shall be provided for 1 bicycle per dwelling, plus 1 space per employee on duty at the care centre
- Off-street parking shall be provided on the basis of 1.0 parking space per dwelling,
  1.0 visitor parking space per 5 dwellings,
  1.0 parking space per employee on duty in the care centre and
  1.0 parking space per 5 children in the care centre.
- In addition to the regulations listed above, other regulations may apply. These include the general **development** regulations of Section 4 (secondary **development**, **yards**, projections into yards, lighting, agricultural setbacks, etc.); the specific use regulations of Section 5; the **landscaping** and fencing provisions of Section 6; and the parking and loading regulations of Section 7.
- As per Section 4.10.2 All buildings and structures, excluding perimeter fencing (garden walls and fences) on lots abutting City Roads as identified on Schedule "B" shall not be sited closer to the City Road than the setback as per the appropriate zone measured from the offset Rights of Way as illustrated on Schedule "B". (Bylaw 5440)
