QUALIFICATIONS FOR ELECTORS

A **RESIDENT elector** is an individual who is qualified to vote in a jurisdiction by virtue of **living (residing)** in the City of Vernon. To sign an elector response form as a resident elector a person must:

1. Be 18 years of age or older at the time of signing this elector response form; and
2. Be a Canadian Citizen; and
3. Have lived in British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before signing this elector response form; and
4. Have been a City of Vernon resident for at least the last 30 days before signing this elector response form; and
5. Not be disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

A **NON-RESIDENT property elector** is an individual who **does not live (does not reside)** in the City of Vernon but is entitled to vote by virtue of owning a real property in the City of Vernon. To sign an elector response form as a non-resident property elector a person must:

1. Not be entitled to register as a resident elector in the City of Vernon; and
2. Be 18 years of age or older at the time of signing this elector response form; and
3. Be a Canadian Citizen; and
4. Have lived in British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before signing this elector response form; and
5. Not be disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law; and
6. Be the only persons who are registered owners of the real property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust; and
7. Be a registered owner of real property within the City of Vernon for at least 30 days before signing this elector response form.
 - a. If a property is owned by **more than one** individual, only **one** of them may sign an elector response form (with the written consent of the majority of the owners);
 - b. A person may register as a non-resident property elector in relation to **one** parcel of real property in the City of Vernon

NOTE: There is no Corporate Vote – No corporation is entitled to be registered as an elector or have a representative registered as an elector and no corporation is entitled to vote.

INSTRUCTIONS

If you are **OPPOSED** to the proposed boundary extension for land located on 5849 Silver Star Road (BX Elementary School), legally described as Lot 1, Plan KAP12270, Section 12, Tp. 8, ODYD, you can sign and submit this elector response form if you qualify as an elector in the City of Vernon.

If you are **NOT OPPOSED** to the proposed boundary extension, you need not do anything.

The number of electors is estimated to be 34,573. If ten (10%) percent [3,457] of the estimated number of electors in the City of Vernon sign an elector response form in opposition to the proposed boundary extension, the City cannot extend the boundary as proposed without receiving the assent to the electors by referendum.
