All qualified Resident and Non-resident property electors for the City Vernon may vote at an Advance Voting Opportunity and at the time of registering as an elector must produce <u>two (2)</u> <u>pieces of acceptable identification</u> (at least one with a signature).

The following are examples of <u>Acceptable Identification:</u>

- BC Driver's License
- BC Identification Card
- Vernon Tax Notice
- ICBC Vehicle Insurance Documents
- Social Insurance Card

- BC Services Card (BC CareCard)
- Credit Card
- Utility Bill
- Citizenship Card

\*\*Please note the <u>combined</u> BC Driver's Licence / BC Services Card is <u>considered to be one</u> <u>piece</u> of acceptable identification for the purpose of voting.

#### **ASSENT VOTING**

The following question will be submitted to the electorate of the City of Vernon:

"Are you in favour of "Active Living Centre Loan Authorization Bylaw 5908" which would authorize the Corporation of the City of Vernon to borrow up to \$121 million dollars, with interest, over a period not exceeding 30 years in order to finance the construction of an Active Living Centre to be located at 3501 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue?"

# **ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS**

## **RESIDENT ELECTORS:**

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day for the by-election; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration (**April 14, 2022**); and
- a resident of the City of Vernon; and
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

## NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day for the by-election; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration (April 14, 2022); and
- a registered owner of real property in the City of Vernon for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration (September 14, 2022); and
- not entitled to register as a resident elector; and
  - the only persons who are registered owners of the real property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust; and
  - not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law; and

• if there is more than one registered owner of the property, <u>only one</u> of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.
