QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on or before general voting day (October 15, 2022);
- Resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and

 Not disqualified by the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, being elected to, or holding office.

NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS FOR SCRUTINEERS ACTIVE LIVING CENTRE LOAN AUTHORIZATION BYLAW ASSENT VOTING

On Saturday, October 15, 2022 the following question will be submitted to the electorate of the City of Vernon, pending approval of the Loan Authorization Bylaw from the Ministry:

"Are you in favour of "Active Living Centre Loan Authorization Bylaw 5908" which would authorize the Corporation of the City of Vernon to borrow up to \$121 million dollars, with interest, over a period not exceeding 30 years in order to finance the construction of an Active Living Centre to be located at 3501 43rd Avenue?"

Scrutineers for and against the question must be appointed if applications are received from persons who wish to volunteer for the positions. Only persons entitled to vote as electors in this assent voting opportunity are entitled to act as scrutineers.

If sufficient applications are received, one scrutineer for and one scrutineer against the question will be appointed for each voting place. One scrutineer for the question and one scrutineer against the question will also be appointed to be present at the determination of the official results and, if necessary, at a judicial recount.

Notice is further given that applications to act as a scrutineer <u>must</u> be received by the Chief or Deputy Chief Election Officer as follows:
