 Initial	I understand the City will turn the water off at the curb stop where possible. During this period, I will ensure the water shut off valve to the house is closed and that the City of Vernon will not be responsible for any water leaks. NOTE: A water meter reading will be taken as of the stop date if the water cannot be turned off.
Initial	Charges will automatically start on the service charge re-start date noted above. <u>To have the water turned on, customers must call 250-550-3620 to request an appointment.</u>
Initial	I accept the \$65.00 water service call out fee for each turn off and turn on of the water at the property. NOTE: A water meter reading will be taken as of the stop date if the water cannot be turned off.
Initial	I understand the Greater Vernon Water Vacant Land fee and meter renewal fee (Bylaw # 2864, 2020), will remain in effect.
Initial	If the property is sold during the period that the water has been turned off, the service charges will start automatically as of the purchase date.
Initial	Temporary extension of service charges is not available for unmetered accounts. I understand that <u>a</u> <u>water meter must be installed and inspected</u> at the property and that no consumption is to be used when services charges are temporarily shut off. Any consumption on the water meter will start the service charges back to the original service charge stop date.
