

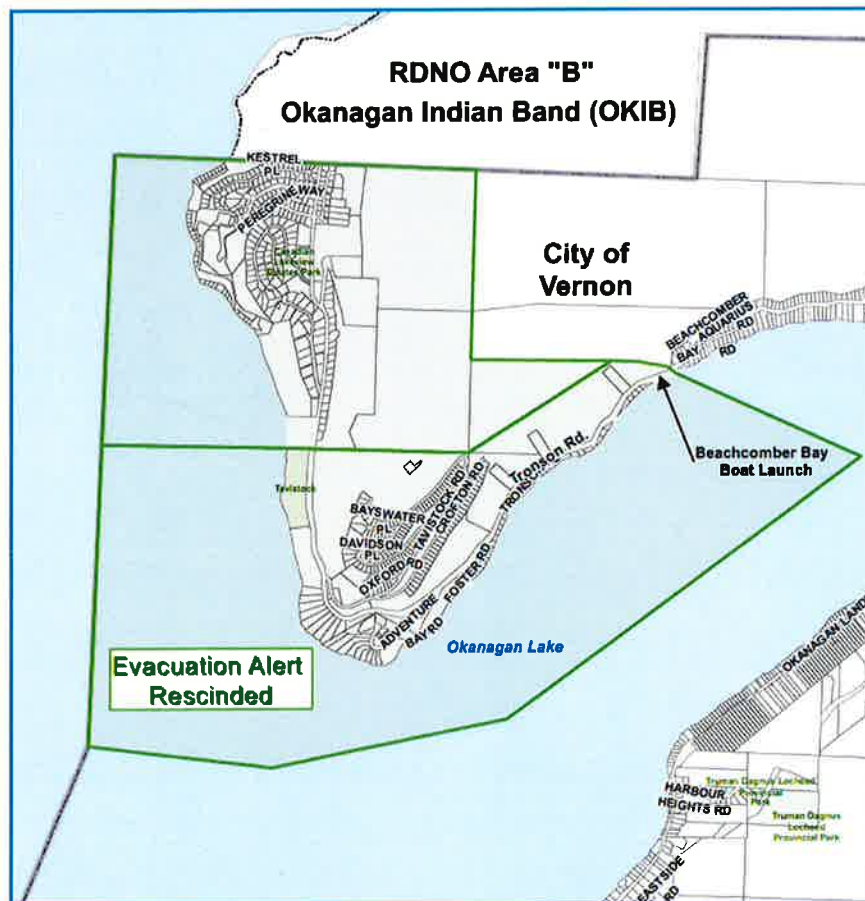
## EVACUATION ALERT RESCINDED TO ALL CLEAR City of Vernon

Date: September 1, 2021 Time: 1:00pm

The Evacuation Alert, pursuant to Section 6.1 of the City of Vernon *Emergency Program Bylaw #5645*, issued on August 6, 2021 to a portion of the City of Vernon has been **rescinded**.

The Alert was put in place for the following areas:

- Canadian Lakeview Estates in its entirety;
- Adventure Bay in its entirety; and
- 8125 to 9280 Tronson Road.



No Evacuation Alerts within the City of Vernon remain in effect at this time. Should conditions change, an Evacuation Alert and / or Order could be reinstated as necessary.

- Remain aware and informed of the current White Rock Lake wildfire.
