SUBJECT: DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT APPLICATIONS: REVISED DATE FOR RETURN TO IN-PERSON INPUT

At its Regular Meeting of July 19, 2021, Council passed the following resolution:


“THAT in person submissions for Development Variance Permit applications be re-instated for the Regular Meeting of September 7, 2021 as outlined in the memorandum titled “Development Variance Permit Applications: Return to In-Person Public Input” dated July 6, 2021, respectfully submitted by the Manager, Long Range Planning and Sustainability.”

This resolution arose in response to the provincial restart plan and the easing of restrictions regarding public attendance at Council meetings. The September 7, 2021 date was identified so the in stream development variance permit (DVP) applications would be treated the same as the newer applications being processed and considered at the same August 16, 2021 Council meeting (i.e. only written submissions for all of the applications). In light of the public attendance at the July 19 Council meeting and their interest in addressing Council about a DVP, Administration recommends immediately re-instating in-person public input. If Council is supportive, Administration will connect with all applicants and residents in the corresponding notification areas to advise of the option to submit written comments or to attend and address Council in person.
