Road Update: Temporary transit disruptions on routes 7 and 8

BC Transit routes 7 and 8 are experiencing service disruptions due to construction activity in the Lakeshore Park area. Temporary routes have been set up to accommodate the construction. It is expected that the work will be completed today; however, should the work continue into tomorrow, the information below will remain in effect.

The road is closed at Tronson and Lakeshore on October 4, from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. All stops between Kin Beach and Okanagan Landing Road are closed.

Transit stops from Lakeshore Road to Tronson Road will be closed as well.

Buses will travel routes as follows:

- Route 7 - Turn left off Scott Road and head back towards downtown on Tronson, left onto Okanagan Landing Road.
- Route 8 - A temporary stop has been placed close to the corner of Tronson and Tronson. Turn left off of Tronson Road onto Tronson and head back towards downtown. Turn left onto Okanagan landing and continue regular route. Maps will be posted at downtown exchange.
