### **City-operated RV sani-dump station to open for Victoria Day long weekend**

The City of Vernon's temporary RV sani-dump station has been relocated and will be available for use by Saturday morning (May 22), in time for the Victoria Day long week.

The station is now located at **3501 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue**, behind Kal Tire Place, on the former Kin Race Track lands.

The sani-dump has a one-way access to maintain the flow of traffic, so motorists are asked to enter at the east entrance and exit on the west end of the site.

Previously, the sani-dump station was located in the 3700 block of 31<sup>st</sup> Street. As part of the City's 2021 Capital Projects plan, 31<sup>st</sup> Street will be rehabilitated between 35<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues, making access to the sani-dump difficult throughout the summer months.

The RV sani-dump station includes two waste dumping and water filling stations and stacking distance to accommodate approximately eight recreational vehicles at a time. A \$4.00 payment can be made in cash at the deposit box or pay-by-phone using location 4736.
