Road re-paving projects to take place on 48th Avenue and 34th Street

UPDATE as of August 31:

The paving schedule for 34th Street has been amended slightly due to an unexpected change in weather. The paving on 34th Street between 25th Avenue and Okanagan Avenue will now take place on September 7 between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

The overnight re-paving of 48th Avenue will continue as previously scheduled.

The City thanks everyone for their patience and understanding while this work is being completed.

The City would like to advise the public that a couple of road re-paving projects will be taking place over the next week. Construction will take place overnight (7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.) to reduce impact to motorists traveling during the day.

Starting August 29, re-paving will begin on 48th Avenue between 24th Street and Anderson Way. Re-paving of this area is expected to take approximately five nights and should be complete by the morning of September 3.

Starting August 30, re-paving will begin on 34th Street between 25th Avenue and Okanagan Avenue. Re-paving of this area is expected to take approximately three nights and should be complete by the morning of September 2.

Motorists traveling in the area are reminded to follow all traffic control devices and to slow down. Access to homes and businesses will be maintained during the projects.
