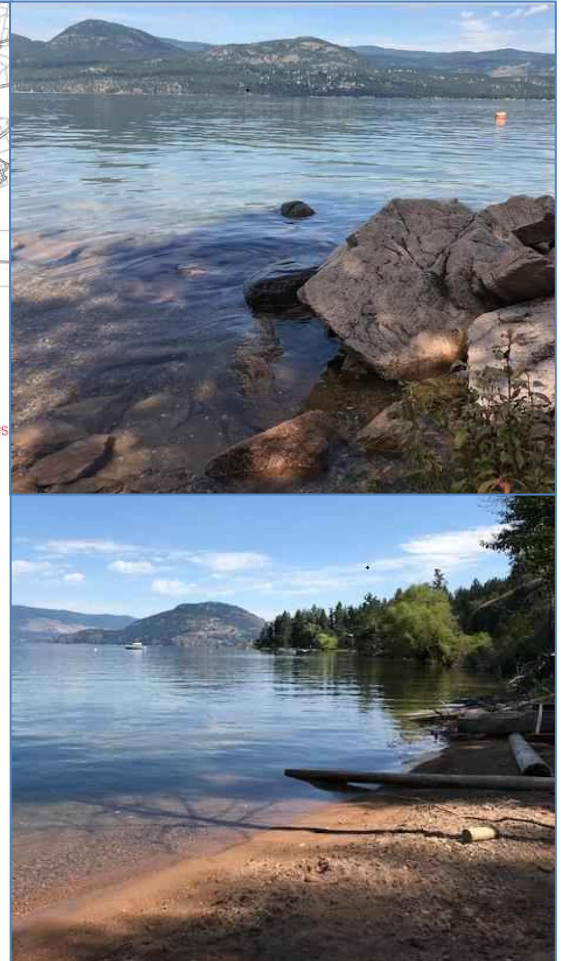
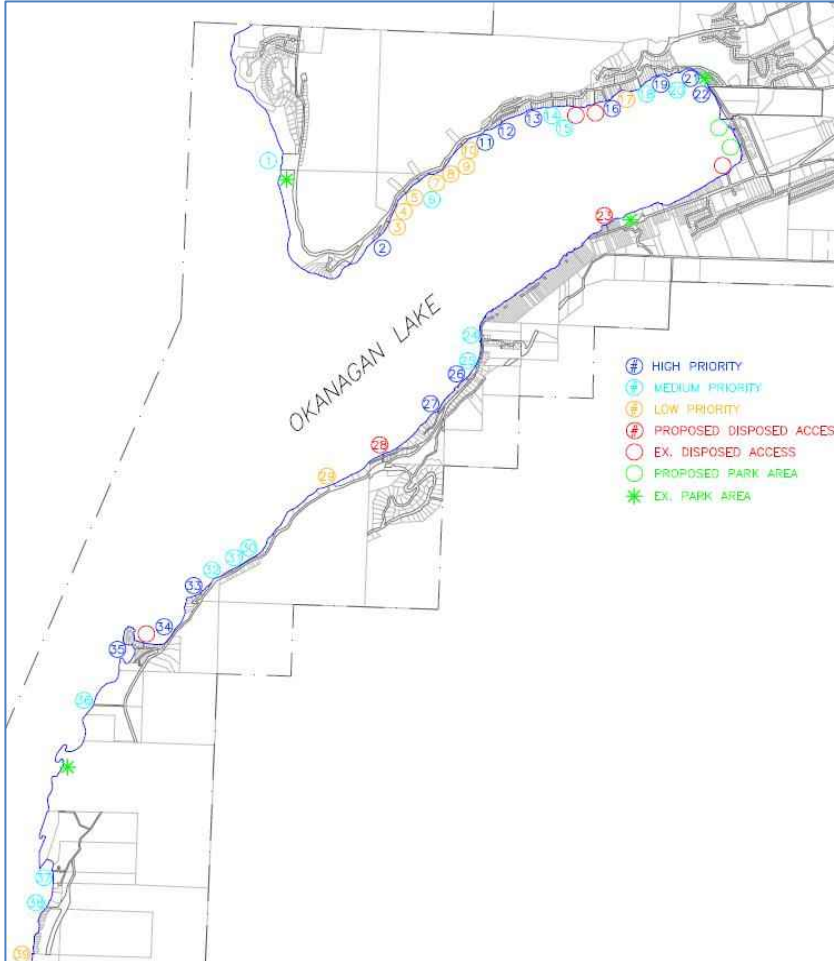


LAKE ACCESS SITES

PROJECT #2021-34



Total Capital Costs: \$ 400,000
Operation and Maintenance Estimated Yearly Costs: \$ 25,000

Project Summary

One of Council's Strategic Plan 2019-2022 goals is to develop a minimum of one lake access site per year. At its Committee of the Whole Meeting of November 27, 2017, Council directed Administration to build four lake access sites (Site 25, 22, 21, and 11). Considerable preparation work has been completed to deal with encroachments, obtain appropriate permits, and complete required reports and plans (e.g. concept plans, environmental reports, archaeological reports, etc.), though construction has yet to begin. In 2021, it is planned that any carry-over lake access funding be used to complete development of the four lake accesses. The additional \$400,000 is to be used towards preparing for and developing another lake access to be determined by Council and repairing existing concrete boat launches.
