

City of Vernon Cost Share Bike Rack Program



With more cyclists in Vernon commuting to school, work and shopping, the City of Vernon is delighted to work with your business to provide a bike rack for your customers. This program is based on a first come, first serve basis and available funding. Once all funding has been allocated, businesses will be placed on a waitlist for the following year.

The City will provide a bike rack to an existing business. The City requires a site visit to determine the suitability of the rack and location. The cost of the rack varies depending on rack selection and site location. The City covers the cost of bike rack which can vary from approximately \$300 to \$1,000. The pick-up of the new bike rack and delivery is the business owner's responsibility. New business development does not qualify for this program.

The installation, upkeep, repair, and maintenance is the responsibility of the business owner. The rack must be installed on an asphalt surface or on an existing cement pad and follow the installation guidelines.

When referring to a business, for the bike City bike rack program, "business" is defined as the property that is open for a commercial, industrial, institutional, professional or retail undertaking. The business owner requires a current City of Vernon business licence.
